INTRODUCTION

Do you have a problem getting around because of a lack of accessible transport?

Do you have days when you are just “under the weather” and need help getting to the shops, visiting friends or travelling to an appointment?

Are you, because of a disability, unable to stand whilst you wait for buses and trains?

Let Harrow’s voluntary transport schemes provide a solution.

Harrow Community Transport (HCT)

HCT offer a team of volunteer car drivers who are able to provide a reliable and competitively priced “Door-to-door” transport service.

Using the volunteers own cars you can be picked up from your home at a time convenient to you (within reason) and taken to that all important appointment that you cannot miss, go to visit friends, both locally and further afield, go to the shops or library.

HCT can even arrange transport to get you to and from your UK holiday destination.

HCT offer wheelchair accessible vehicles and a mini-bus for group transport.

Barbara Bus Fund

If you are a wheelchair user and find it impossible to travel by public transport and find transferring to a car or taxi difficult, the Barbara Bus Fund (Stanmore) may be able to help with its fleet of six specially adapted vehicles which enable wheelchair users to travel without transferring.

Friends, relatives or carers may be nominated to drive the vehicles, providing they are aged between 25 and 75 years of age and have a current & clean full driving license.

You may use the vehicles to travel whenever and wherever you wish up to a maximum continuous period of two weeks.
